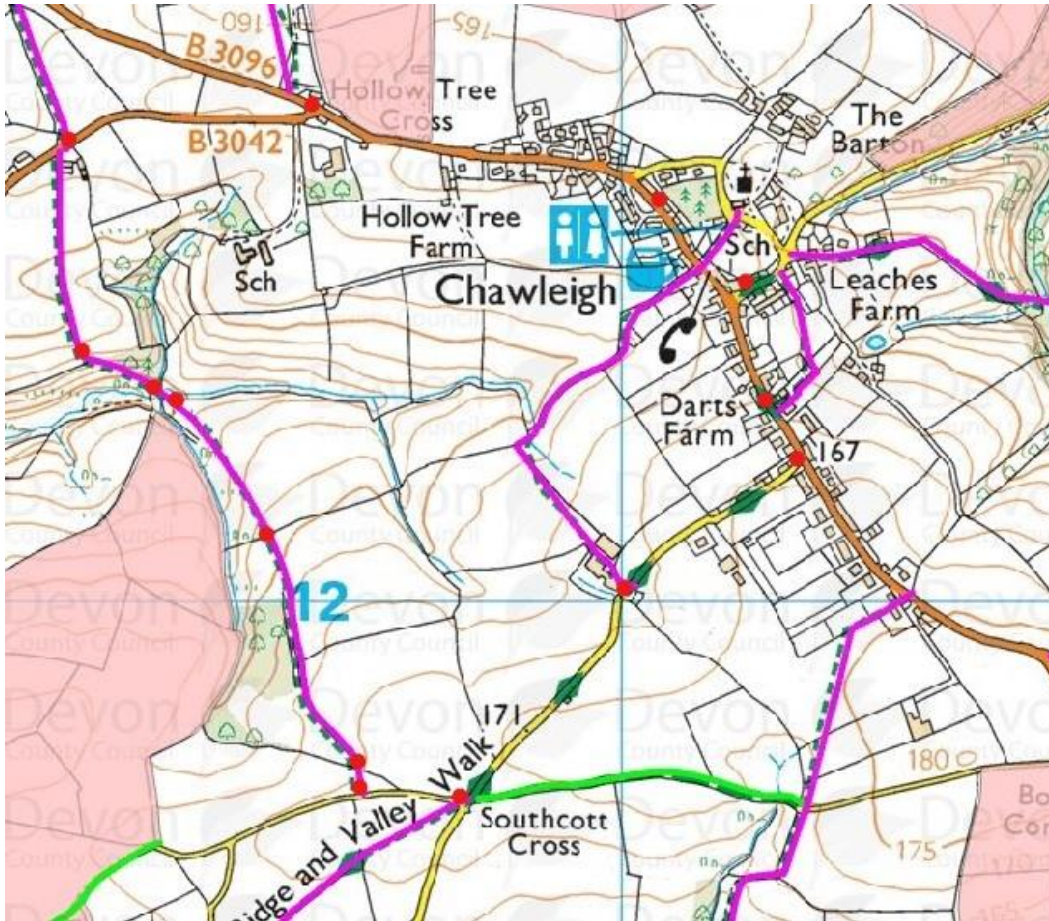


Chawleigh walk 1

2.5mile (45mins) easy circular walk



From the Royal Oak or Earl of Portsmouth take the B3042 east passing Darts Farm as shown on the map and take the first road on the right into Shooting Lane. Follow the lane past Tatworthy Farm until you reach the crossroads known as Southcott Cross.

Turn right and follow the road for about 500yards until on the right side you will see a stile (soon to be replaced by kissing gate).

Cut across the field and through the farm gate opposite. Keeping close to the hedge on the right side, pass the small copse to the left containing old trees and new saplings (one of which is a Queen's Jubilee celebration tree with a plaque) until you reach the next farm gate.

Go through this gate and bear slightly left, heading downhill towards another wooded area in the corner of the field, where you will see a galvanised pedestrian gate. Go through the gate across two little bridges over a stream and follow the fenced off area on your right until you reach the next pedestrian gate.

Go through this gate and up the track to the next farm gate.

Go through the gate and cross the field keeping to the right until you reach the B3042 road again.

Turn right passing 'The Pheasantry' and continue along the road until you reach Hollow Tree Farmhouse.

Turn right here staying on the B3042 through the village, past the village shop. The Royal Oak is a little further on and if you continue past the Telephone kiosk you will reach the Earl of Portsmouth.
